From the very beginning, the Augustinians of the Assumption (Assumptionists) have been engaged in a wide variety of apostolic works. All that advances the coming of the Reign of God has always been deemed worthy of our apostolic energy.

It's a preference for poor, in response to the Gospel and to the Church calling us today to be on their side. For us too it's a consequence of our own vow to live as poor men. Some will dedicate themselves full-time to this work: with marginalized people of every kind, in hospitals and in prisons, "worker priests" or volunteers in different organizations ... But all of us try to live in union with the poor, because "the poor will always be with us", because the poor are too often neglected even within the Church. This is a bias that the Assumption encourages.

Our Province of North America is specifically responsible for the missions in East Africa (Kenya, Uganda, and Tanzania), Mexico and the Philippines. We provide personnel and financial assistance that is indispensable in order to maintain our charitable works (schools and nurseries) and formation programs for both laity and clergy in these countries. Many of our apostolates in these countries specifically work to better the living conditions of the impoverished brothers and sisters we live with and minister to. In the Philippines, we sponsor education and aid programs for underprivileged villages both in the Manila area and in other mission centers. Our parish in Orizaba, Veracruz Mexico ministers to an underserved indigenous community.

Reverend Oswaldo Garcia Sanchez will be joining us on June 14-15 to celebrate and share more about the Missionary Cooperative Appeal for the Augustinians of the Assumption.

Algunos se dedicarán a tiempo completo a este trabajo: con personas marginadas de todo tipo, en hospitales y cárceles, "curas trabajadores" o voluntarios en diferentes organizaciones... Pero todos nosotros tratamos de vivir en unión con los pobres, porque "los pobres siempre estarán con nosotros", porque los pobres son demasiado a menudo abandonados incluso dentro de la Iglesia. Éste es un sesgo que la Asunción fomenta.

Nuestra Provincia de América del Norte es específicamente responsable de las misiones en África Oriental (Kenia, Uganda y Tanzania), México y Filipinas. Proporcionamos personal y asistencia financiera que es indispensable para mantener nuestras obras caritativas (escuelas y guarderías) y programas de formación tanto para laicos como para clérigos en estos países. Muchos de nuestros apóstolados en estos países trabajan específicamente para mejorar las condiciones de vida de los hermanos y hermanas empobrecidos con quienes vivimos y a quienes ministramos. En Filipinas, patrocinamos programas de educación y ayuda para pueblos desfavorecidos tanto en el área de Manila como en otros centros de misión. Nuestra parroquia en Orizaba, Veracruz México ministra a una comunidad indígena desatendida.
